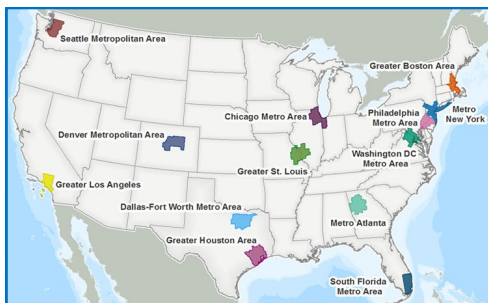

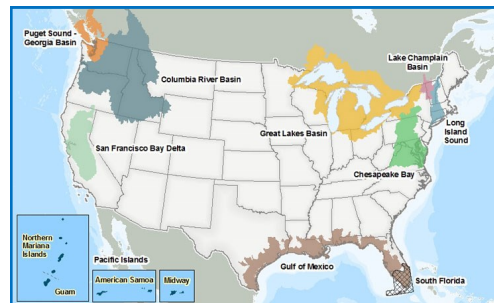

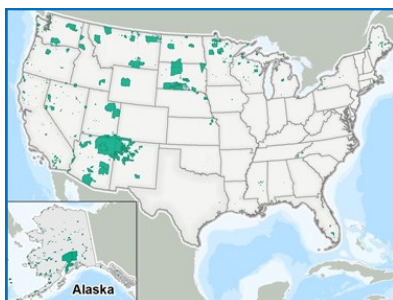
2012 Location-Specific Analyses



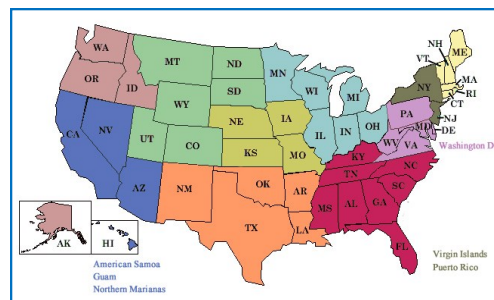
Urban Communities
