Dear Mr. Johnson:

The Dickson Water System's water treatment facility has been classified by the Division of Water Supply as a "Wester Treatment-3" facility. A recent review of the facility's design capacity, nature of the raw water, treatment techniques employed at the facility, chemical feed operations, and laboratory practices, has indicated that the classification should be upgraded. Classification of water treatment facilities is determined by the Division using a scoring system based primarily upon the above referenced criteria. Based upon a classification score of sixty-seven (67), the Dickson Water System water treatment facility is hereby upgraded to the classification of "Water Treatment-4". The effective date of this change is April 1, 2000.
