Pesticide Registration Service Fees

Partnership Grants

Under PRIA 2, the amounts set aside for partnership grants in Section 33(c)(3)(B)(ii) were \$750,000 each for fiscal years 2008 and 2009 and \$500,000 each for fiscal years 2010 through 2012. Partnership grant funds were augmented in FY 2010 with Advanced Monitoring Initiative funds from the EPA's Office of the Science Advisor to fund a total of five projects. In FY 2011, PRIA 2 funds supported three IPM grants totaling approximately \$500,000 that focused on IPM in both agricultural and urban sectors. In FY 2012 \$500,000 in PRIA 2 funds supported a cooperative agreement for the National Pesticide Information Network to provide objective, science-based information about pesticides to the public. <u>Table 2</u> provides a summary of this program's accomplishments with FY 2008 through FY 2012 funds.
