






## Strontia Springs Zone: Pre-treatment conditions

## Status of Current Projects (FY11-13)

Currently Implementing almost 25,750 acres in all Watersheds:

- 13,412 acres (52%) are within DW's Zones of Concern
- 18,077 acres are within South Platte watersheds
- 10,673 acres fully completed (7,801 in South Platte)

#### **Projected Outcomes:**

- 21,029 acres with reduced hazardous fuels
- 389,892 tons of biomass removed or dispersed
- 3,720 acres to be reforested within Hayman & Buffalo Creek burn areas
- 498,480 tree seedlings planted
