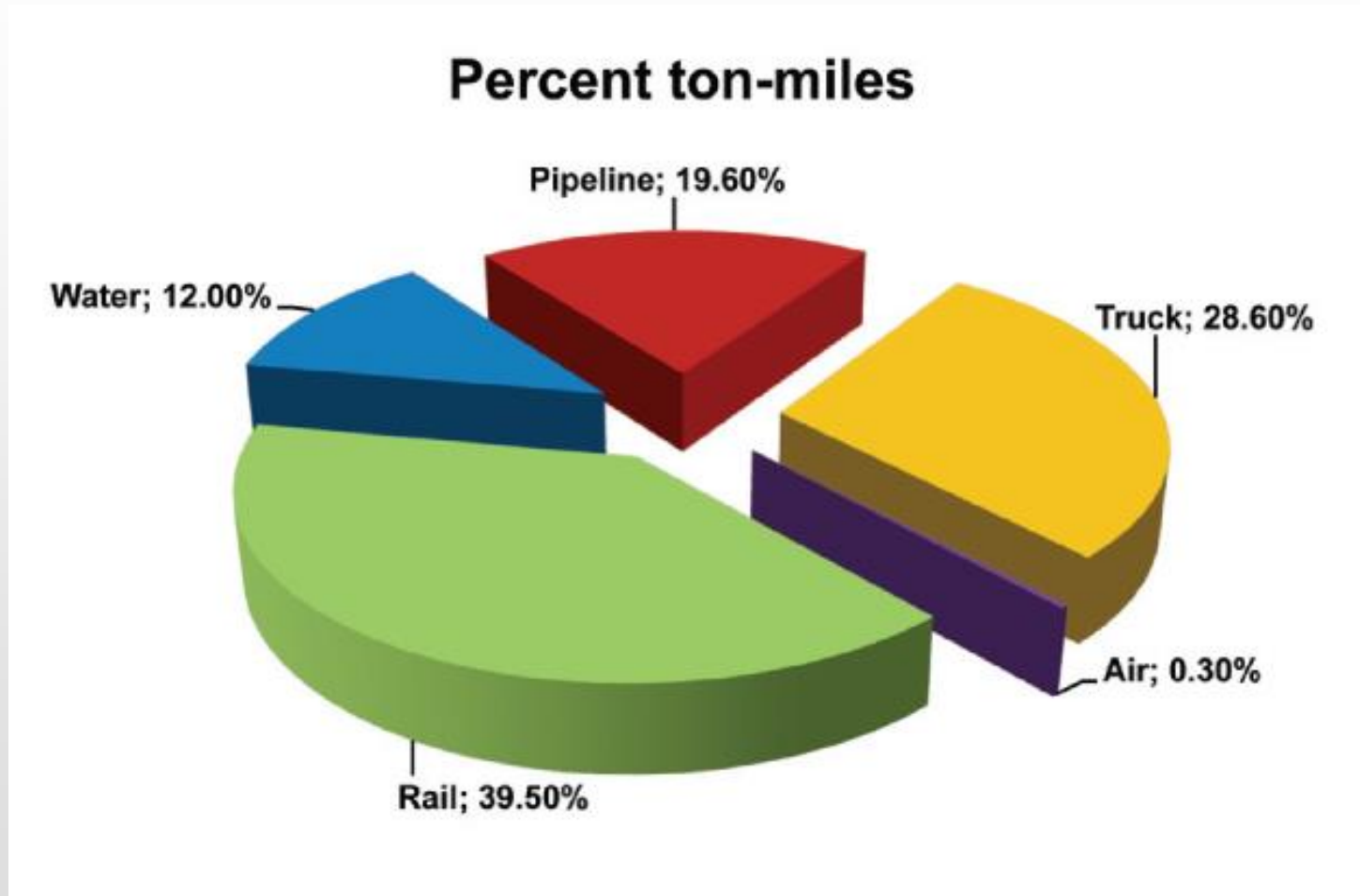
Waybill Sample 2010 - All Commodities

- 132 rail-rail grade crossings

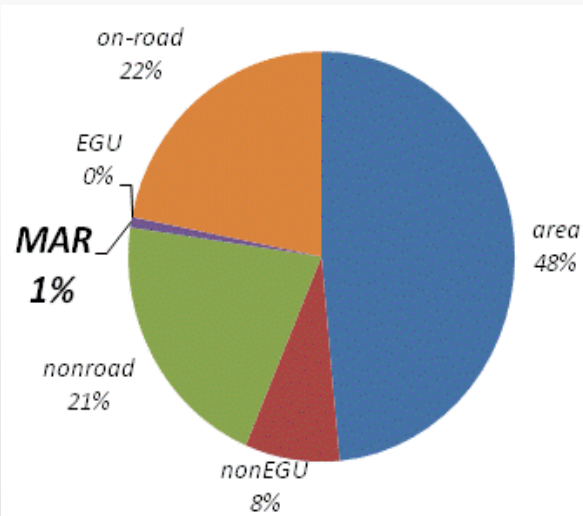

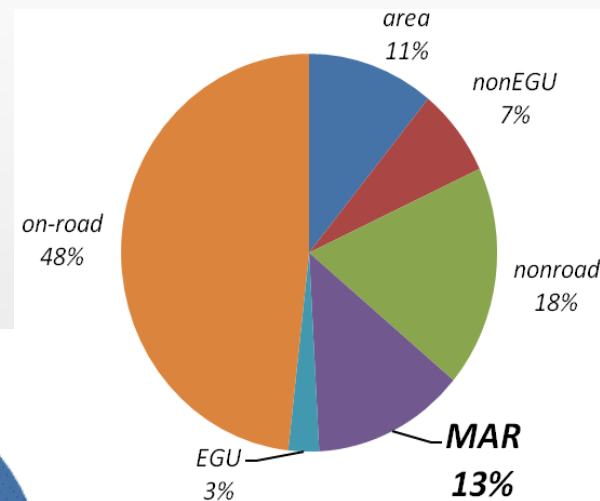

Ozone and PM_{2.5} Source Contributions

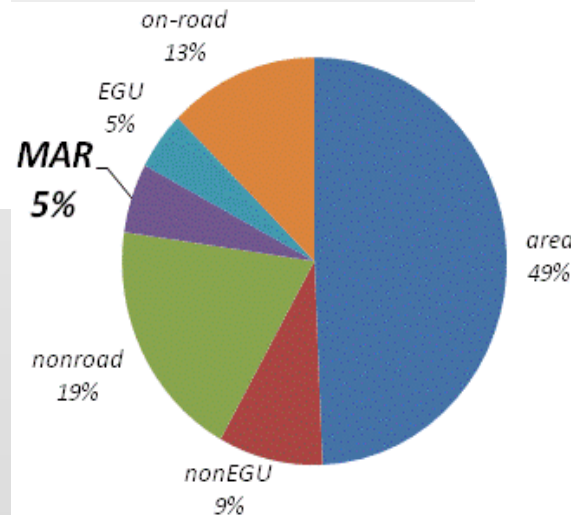

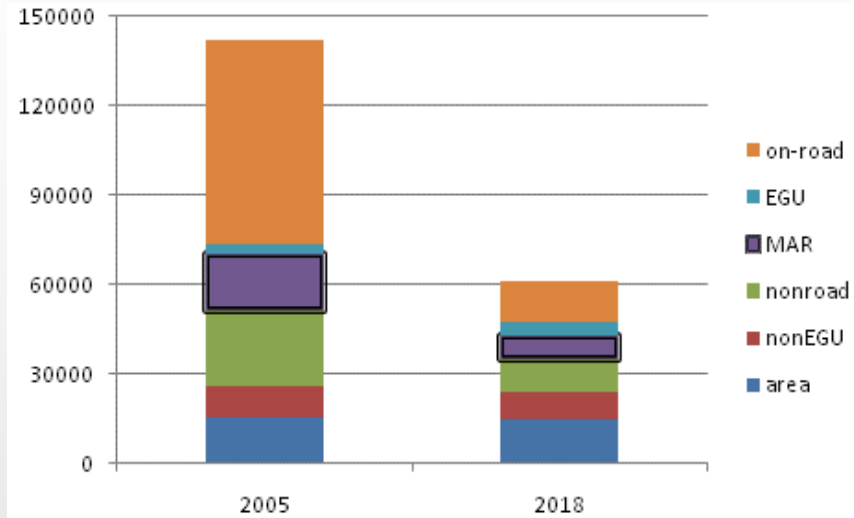
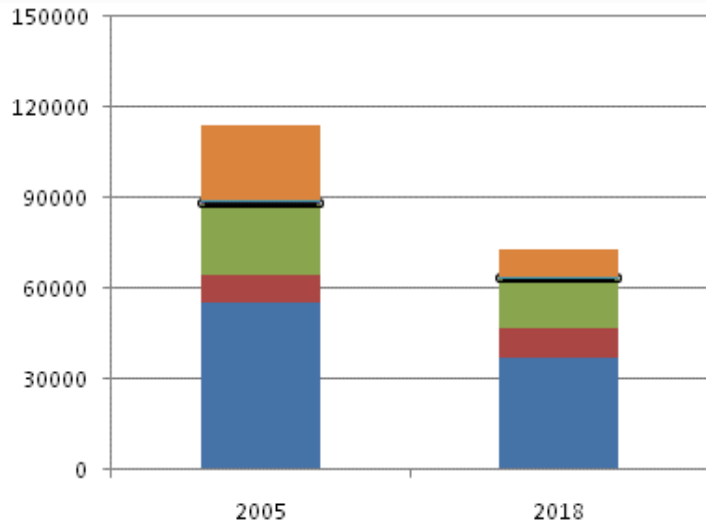

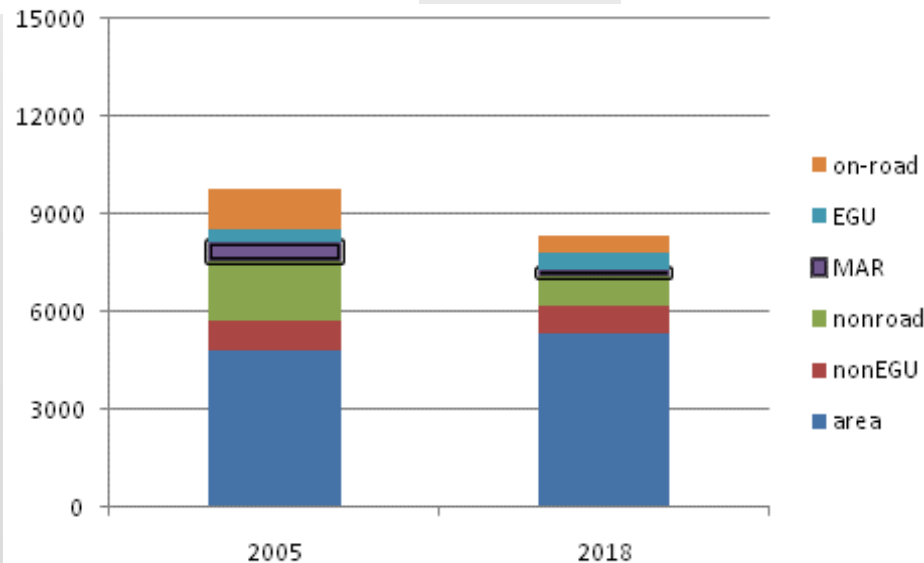
