(CREATE - Chicago Region Environmental And Transportation Efficiency Program)

Chicago Area Rail Infrastructure

- 78 yards, including 21 intermodal (rail-truck)
- 2,800 route-miles of track
- 1,100 viaducts and bridges

Daily Activity

- 1,300 trains
- 45,000 rail cars enroute to Chicago
- 13,000 rail cars interchanged
- 20,000 truck moves through intermodal gates



Chicago: The Nation's Transportation Hub


- Chicago is the world's 3rd busiest intermodal hub.
- 800 passenger trains and 500 freight trains go through Chicago every day.
- Chicago's rail network is a key part of national regional and local economy.



The U.S. Rail Network Depends on

Chicago

- 25 percent of all U.S. rail traffic touches Chicago
- 46 percent of all **intermodal** units in the U.S. touch Chicago
- 54 percent of intermodal units to/from the ports of Seattle/Tacoma touch Chicago
- 26 percent of intermodal units to/from Los Angeles/Long Beach touch Chicago

What is CREATE?

A \$3.8 billion public-private partnership program designed to improve transportation flow through Chicago focusing on:

- Increased capacity, speed, reliability for freight train traffic
- Separation of freight & passenger trains at 6 key junctions
- Elimination of 25 road/rail grade crossings (grade separations)

Why CREATE?

- Freight rail trade with Chicago (by value) will triple from 2011 to 2040." *
- Passenger, freight and motorist delays are experienced daily on the current system
- The region must improve freight movement and mitigate negative impacts

CREATE Benefits

- New overpasses, underpasses and other improvements will reduce the time Chicago-area motorists spend waiting at railroad crossings by thousands of hours a day.
- Travel times for commuters on many Metra lines and Amtrak will improve and schedules will become more reliable.
- Emissions from cars, trucks and locomotives will be greatly reduced, improving air quality.
- Noise from idling or slow-moving trains will be reduced in residential neighborhoods.



CREATE Funding Received/ Committed

- \$338.8 million : Federal
- \$234 million : Railroad partners
- \$410 million : Illinois DOT
- \$10.1 million : Chicago DOT
- \$236.6 million : Pre-CREATE funding
