

Transition Update: National Radon Program Services

History of the Transfer

- Transferred on September 26, 2009 from National Safety Council (NSC) to Kansas State University (KSU)
- KSU and NSC working together with EPA and states to ensure a smooth transition
- KSU will operate National Radon Program Services through April 30, 2011 to cover two complete poster contests








Transition Update: National Radon Program Services

Radon Hotline

- Current status:
 - Four hotlines with one pending transfer
 - National Hispanic hotline discontinued by January 1st
- Full implementation:
 - Callers encouraged via answering machine to visit the Web site at <u>www.sosradon.org</u> for information and offered three options:
 - 1. Speak to someone directly if available
 - 2. Receive fact sheet with test kit coupon
 - 3. Direct transfer to state radon program











Transition Update: National Radon Program Services

Test Kit Coupon Status

- Long and short-term test kits will continue to be offered online, by mail or fax, and by coupon program.
- Prices for the kits are \$15 and \$25.
- The same kits that NSC used will be used for foreseeable future and current supply.
- Sales will (hopefully) provide revenue to enable program activities and projects in support of poster contest.

You may complete our test kit order form electronically @ and print it out to mail or fax in.

Option 3 - Print and mail coupon

You may download a Radon test kit coupon and mail it in.
