

Notification Under the Academic Labs Rule

- An eligible academic entity must notify its authorized state (or regional EPA office) that it is opting into Subpart K
 - □ Use the Site ID form (Form 8700-12) to notify
 - □ Site ID Form has been modified to include new box for Subpart K
- An eligible academic entity must submit a separate Site ID Form for each EPA ID Number (or site) that is opting into the Labs Rule
- When opting in, <u>all</u> laboratories operating under a single EPA ID Number (or at the same site) must opt in
- Not all your sites have to opt in but it is in your best interest to have all the laboratories on a campus operating under the same system
