


Plans for FY09 and beyond

FY08 Success Across Sectors

- \$49.2M DERA grants cover wide range of sectors, technologies and areas of the country
- 119 grants affecting 14,000 vehicles and reducing over life of program:
 - 46,000 tons NOx
 - 2,200 tons PM
 - Benefit/cost ratio = up to 13:1
- First Report to Congress published

Recovery Act Funding





Administrator Jackson announces first ARRA-DERA grants in Cincinnati, OH for school buses

- \$300M in Recovery Act for DERA to support job creation, stimulate economy and lower diesel emissions
 - 600 applications: \$2 billion in requests with over \$2 billion in matching dollars
 - 538 eligible applications
 - Programs in every state and DC
- 100% of funding awarded
- First EPA program to award Recovery Act funds

Recovery Act Projects




- State Program: \$88M
 - 51 State grants
 - (50 States + D.C.)
 - \$1.73 M each
 - All funding has been awarded



- National Program: \$206M (plus ~\$6M for Admin)
 - 90 grants awarded by EPA Regional Offices
 - 14 Emerging Technology Awards by HQ
 - 5 SmartWay Finance Awards by HQ



National Clean Diesel Funding Assistance Program

- One national Request for Proposals
 - Published on/around October 6, 2009
 - Open for ~60 days
 - Closing December 8, 2009
 - Funding from FY09 and FY10 will be combined ~\$64M
 - Applicants submit to EPA Region where project will take place
 - Two-year project periods
 - RFP = Submit only Forms 424, 424A plus Narrative Proposal
 - Tribal Set-Aside

FY09 State Program Funding

- Anticipate 50 States plus D.C. will participate
- Grants will be amended to receive new FY09 funding
 - Base allocation is approximately ~\$235K per State
 - If State matches base allocation, State receives an additional ~\$118K for total of \$353K
 - Total per State with additional State match of \$235K is \$588K
- Process to amend began October 1st
 - States will receive funds in January, 2010
- Any FY10 funding that becomes available will be added to the state's existing programs

SmartWay Clean Diesel Finance Program

- Establishes national, regional, state, or local financial programs for energy efficient and emission control technologies
 - RFP published on/around October 6, 2009
 - Open for ~60 days
 - Closing December 8, 2009
 - Funding from FY09 and FY10 will be combined ~\$12M

Emerging Technologies Program

- Supports the development and commercialization of the next generation of emission reduction technologies
 - RFP published on/around October 6, 2009
 - Open for ~60 days
 - Closing December 8, 2009
 - Funding from FY09 and FY10 will be combined ~\$8M
