

YOU ARE INVITED TO THE CAMP MINDEN SUPERFUND SITE ENVIRONMENTAL WORKSHOPS



The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in cooperation with the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ) and the Louisiana Military Department (LMD), will be holding a series of environmental workshops. These workshops will be educational in nature.

In the first workshop, you will learn about future site activities such as air data collection mechanisms that will be conducted on and around Camp Minden. There will be a detailed PowerPoint presentation about the equipment that will be used, their functions, and where the different equipment will be placed. You will learn about what analyses will be used to measure baseline standards, for the removal actions. In the second workshop, you will learn about response preparedness, including how local officials will notify you if an incident occurs, who will respond, and some basic actions you should be prepared to take to protect your family.

Representatives from the EPA, LDEQ, and LMD will be available to discuss and answer your general monitoring and sampling questions. This is not a formal meeting. You will have the opportunity to learn from and talk directly with agency representatives in an informal setting. We welcome your participation. This meeting is being held in a fully accessible facility.
