But supported by "The Essential Benefit of a Mentor", I'll describe tools I developed such as: "Open Items List (OIL) for Mentoring Sessions", "List and Notebooks of Training Materials (NTM)", "Cumulative Numbered Listing of Materials Read (CNLMR", "Alphabetical List of the "Good Stuff" (ALGS) [aka Best Practices] cross-referenced to the (NTM, NoM, and the CNLMR)", and to keep track of the acronyms: "Compendium of Glossaries and Acronyms (CGA) extracted from NoM:, etc.
