As we reviewed the final report, we realized that we erroneously stated the following:

"The most recent change occurred during a public meeting on May 6th, in which the CSB Board rescinded much of Board Order 2015-01with the exception of Board Orders 24, 27, and 28 in an effort to normalize agency operations. We are currently revisiting Board Orders 24, 27 and 28, and are committed to updating and re-issuing these orders as you will note in the attached plan of action and milestones."

Our response should have not included Board Order 28 as that Board Order is not being updated and is in fact back on the CSB's website.

As an update regarding the documentation of acquisition market research, quality assurance plans, and the registration of contracts in an online contractor performance database (CPARS), the CSB has completed Recommendations #3 – 4 and has made progress on Recommendation #5. We will provide details directly to the OIG at a time to be established between the OIG and CSB.
