Background

Whole effluent toxicity (WET) test and organism culturing videos are an important training tool for EPA Regions and States and others (i.e., laboratories). Due to the recognized need for WET training, USEPA revised the original videos to incorporate EPA's 2002 WET test methods technical updates and has added new features to enhance the training benefits.
