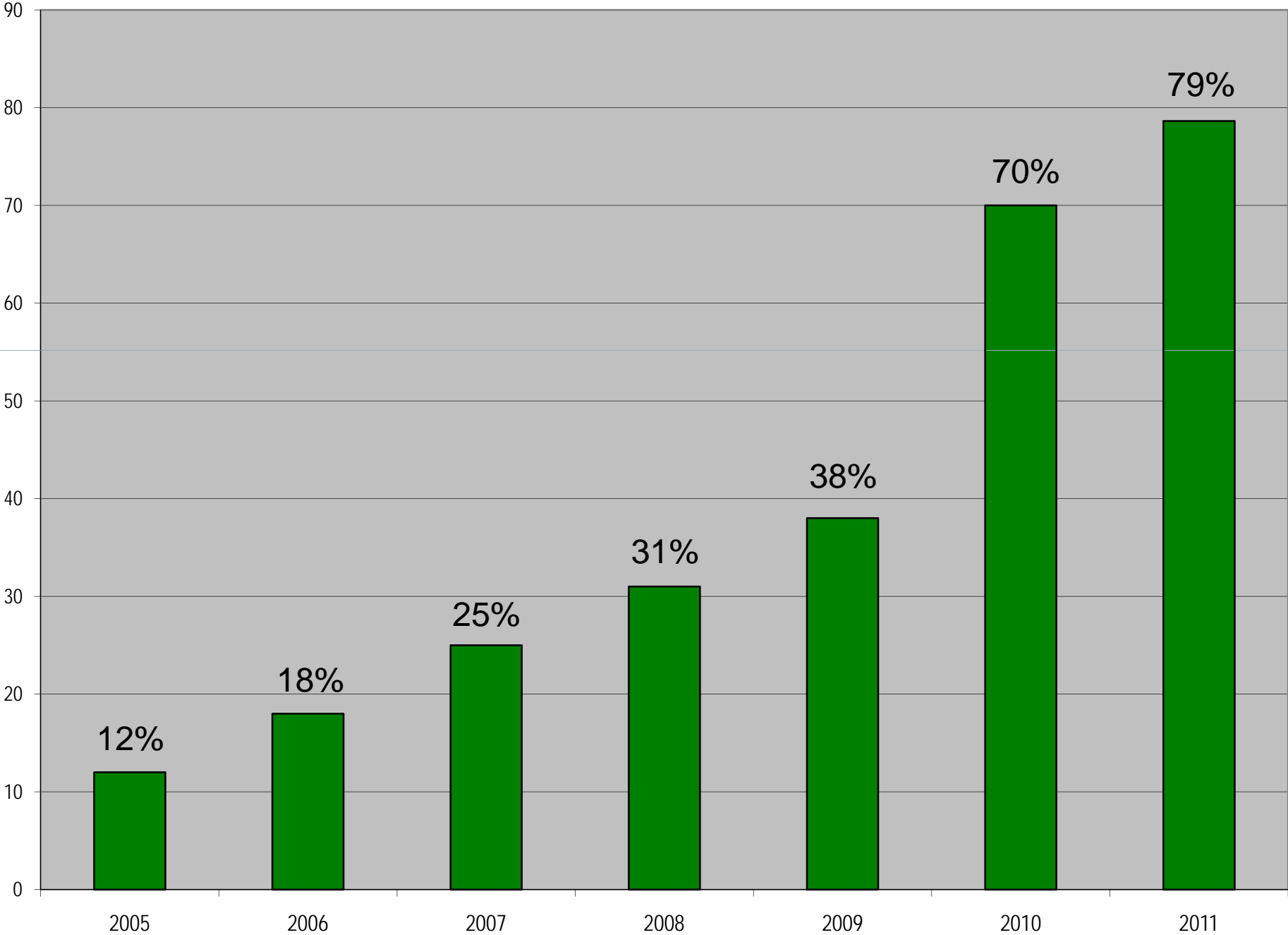

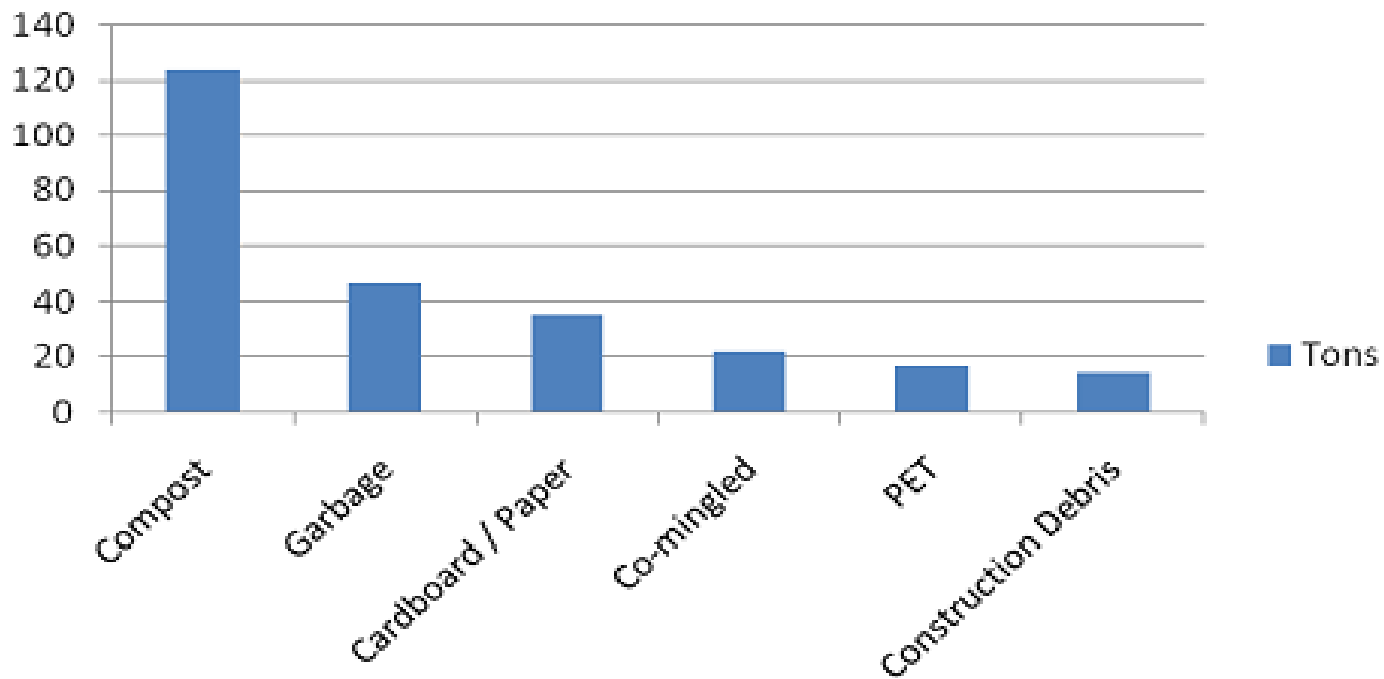


Annual Recycling Rate
