- Identify a list of potential groups/organizations to lead (or co-lead) the entire NOLA Urban Waters Partnership. This will include information on connections to the Urban Waters Federal Partnership and national initiative and capacity to take on the leadership role. <u>This outcome needs to be in position before Workshop #3 to have decision makers</u> in attendance to express their commitment to taking on leadership roles.
