





Figure 1. The Calispell- Cusick Valley restoration planning project boundary.




























Kalispel Wetland Program Plan

Core Elements

- Voluntary Restoration
 - Comprehensive Regional Plan
 - Incorporate existing goals and focus
 - Developing private partnerships
 - Implementation funding
 - Periodically reassess goals
- Monitoring and evaluation UWMEP
 - UCUT (Upper Columbia United Tribes) Wildlife
 Monitoring and Evaluation Program
