- □ Step 1. Convene Leadership Team
 - o Identify and gather a leadership team
 - Assign roles and responsibilities
- □ Step 2. Establish Goals and Identify Obstacles
 - o Define the explicit purpose and determine if the project will include publicity
 - Develop specific, quantifiable goals
 - o Identify known obstacles that may impeded success
- Step 3. Survey Local Efforts and Research Similar Programs
 - Research and develop an understanding of local efforts that may complement or compete with your project
 - Learn from other communities that have taken on similar initiatives
- Step 4. Develop Program/Project Details
 - Define the project's scope and geographic location (if applicable)
 - o Hold conversations with key stakeholders, including "implementers"
 - Confirm that the project fits into other existing community plans and complies with all applicable laws
 - Define and secure needed resources
 - Develop a plan to measure, report, and evaluate quantifiable metrics
 - Step 5. Develop Outreach Plan
 - o Identify a spokesperson and select the best ways to spread the word
 - o Determine what you will report and when to publicize those metrics
 - Set outreach-specific goals
 - Step 6. Implement Program/Project
 - Acquire needed materials, engage staff, complete the project, and implement the outreach plan
- □ Step 7. Monitor and Adjust
 - o Track progress and make adjustments to consistently improve the project
