No later than April 19, 2007 ( <b>63.4560(b)(1)</b> )	<i>Conduct Performance Test<sup>4</sup></i>	October 16, 2004, or no later than 180 days after the compliance date, whichever is later ( <b>63.4560(a)(1)</b> )
No later than April 19, 2007 ( <b>63.4560(b)(2)</b> )	<i>Develop and Implement Work Practice Plan<sup>5</sup></i>	April 19, 2004, or initial startup, whichever is later ( <b>63.4560(a)(2)</b> )
No later than June 18, 2007 ( <b>63.4520(b)</b> )	<i>Results of Initial Performance Tests</i>	December 15, 2004 or within 60 days after completing the performance test, whichever is later ( <b>63.4520(b)</b> )
No later than May 30, 2008 ( <b>63.4510(c)</b> )	<i>Notification of Compliance Status</i>	May 30, 2005 or no later than 30 days following the end of the initial compliance period, whichever is later ( <b>63.4510(c)</b> ) <sup>6</sup>
July 31, 2008, and every January 31 and July 31 thereafter ( <b>63.4520(a)(1)</b> )	<i>Semiannual Compliance Reports</i>	Every January 31 and July 31, after the end of the initial compliance period, <sup>7</sup> ( <b>63.4520(a)(1)</b> )

<sup>2</sup> New affected source: an affected source that the construction or reconstruction of which commenced after December 4, 2002 (**63.4482(c)**).

<sup>3</sup> Applies to add-on controls option only.

<sup>4</sup> Performance tests must be performed for each capture system and add-on control device, except for solvent recovery systems. For solvent recovery systems, the first material balance must be initiated.

<sup>5</sup> Work practice plans must be developed for compliance with the add-on controls option only.

<sup>6</sup> The initial compliance period begins on the day after the compliance date and ends on the last day of the twelfth full month after the compliance date (**63.4540, 63.4550, or 63.4560(a)(3) and (b)(3)**).

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<sup>7</sup> The initial semiannual report must cover the period beginning on the day after the end of the initial compliance period and ends on June 30 or December 31, whichever date is the first date following the end of the initial compliance period. **(63.4520(a)(1))**
