On behalf of Walter Coke, Inc. (Walter Coke), Terracon Consultants, Inc. (Terracon) has prepared Quarterly Progress Report #12 for the work completed July 1, 2015 to September 30, 2015 period for the above-referenced site. This progress report has been prepared in accordance with paragraph 53 of the Order on Consent with effective date of September 24, 2012.

PROGRESS REPORT (JULY 1, 2014 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2015)

Corrective Measures Studies

- Walter Coke received the CMS Data Gap Sampling letter from EPA dated July 17, 2015 requesting a field sampling work plan and Quality Assurance Project Plan (QAPP). The Field Sampling and Analysis Work Plan and QAPP were submitted to EPA on August 21, 2015.
- Walter Coke received draft comments on the Field Sampling and Analysis Work Plan and QAPP in an email from EPA dated September 25, 2015. The Field Sampling and Analysis Work Plan (Revision 1), Field Sampling and Analysis Addendum, and QAPP (Revision 1) were submitted to EPA on October 9, 2015.
- Walter Coke received Comments on Corrective Measures Study SMA 5 Former Pig Iron Foundry and EPA Global Final Comments Applicable to all CMS Reports letters from EPA dated August 26, 2015. Walter Coke submitted CMS for SMA 5 – Former Pig Iron Foundry (Revision 1.0) on September 30, 2015.



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Interim Measures

- Hydraulic Control System was running during this reporting period. The volume of water recovered from July 1, 2015 through September 30, 2015 is 325,295 gallons.
- Groundwater level measurements and groundwater samples were collected from the monitoring wells in August 2015. These results will be reported to EPA in the next Annual Report which is due by August 30, 2016.

Vapor Intrusion

EPA sent a letter dated July 2, 2015 that the soil vapor monitoring points can be removed pursuant to the methodology in the Vapor Intrusion Work Plan. Terracon was able to get in touch with Mr. Eric Herrod on September 9, 2015. Mr. Herrod gave Terracon permission to remove the soil vapor points from his yard.

PROJECTED WORK FOR NEXT REPORTING PERIOD (OCTOBER 1, 2015 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2015)

Corrective Measures Studies

The Field Sampling and Analysis Work Plan (Revision 1), Field Sampling and Analysis Addendum, and QAPP (Revision 1) were submitted to EPA on October 9, 2015. We anticipate EPA approval of these documents during this quarter and anticipate initiation of sampling activities.

Interim Measures

- Collect groundwater samples in November 2015.
- Continue to explore options to improve recovery system.

Vapor Intrusion

Sample port removal has been scheduled for October 14, 2015.
