



Long-term Contracts (Released April 21, 2014)



The Long-term Green Power Contracts list highlights the Green Power Partners that have signed a contract to purchase green power for five years or more. The combined green power use from these contracts amounts to nearly 2.3 billion kilowatt-hours of green power annually, which is equivalent to avoiding the carbon dioxide emissions from the electricity use of more than 217,000 average American households each year.
