Puerto Rico Designation for the New 1-Hour SO₂ NAAQS Withdrawn of initial recommendation and new recommendation

On June 3, 2012 the Puerto Rico Environmental Quality Board (PREQB) submitted the initial designation for all areas in Puerto Rico, pursuant to the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C 7407(d)(1)(A)). PREQB recommended the EPA to classify the Barceloneta/Manatí, Guayama, San Juan, and Guayanilla/Ponce areas as "non-attainment" under the revised NAAQS for SO₂. It also proposed that the Mayaguez and Fajardo/Humacao areas be designated as unclassified areas for SO₂. This initial request was based on monitoring data and results from a refined air dispersion model.

More recently, the PREQB has gathered additional information related to the emission inventory used for the dispersion models demonstration. Since the emission inventory may not reflect the more recent and available information, as required for the sulfur dioxide designation (75 FR 35569), the PREQB is requesting to retire the recommendations contained in the letter dated June 3, 2011.

In consequence, the PREQB is now submitting an "unclassifiable" recommendation for all areas of Puerto Rico.
