Dear Administrator Garvin:

Thank you for your February 16, 2016, letter concerning air quality designations in Maryland for the 2010 1-hour sulfur dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>) National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS). The Maryland Department of the Environment (the Department) appreciates the opportunity to provide the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) with additional technical analyses regarding the sulfur dioxide concentrations in the area of the Herbert A. Wagner Generating Station (Wagner).

The Department, in consultation with Raven Power, operator of the Wagner station, has conducted refined modeling of the 1-hour SO<sub>2</sub> emissions in the area of Wagner, and the modeling shows that the area is in attainment of the standard. In addition, the Sierra Club modeling that shows nonattainment has significant flaws. Please see the enclosed technical support document.
