The Top 30 K-12 Schools list represents the largest green power users among K-12 school partners within the Green Power Partnership. The combined green power use of these organizations amounts to more than 97 million kilowatt-hours of green power annually, which is equivalent to the electricity use of nearly 9,000 average American homes each year.
