Subject: Comments on Revised NAAQS for NO2

Dear Mr. Blumenfeld:

Thank you for notifying the Big Pine Paiute Tribe of the Owens Valley (Tribe) of the opportunity to comment prior to US EPA's designating lands as "attainment," "nonattainment," or "unclassifiable" with regard to strengthened National Ambient Air Quality Standards for Nitrogen Dioxide.

US Highway 395 bisects the Big Pine Indian Reservation, so the Tribe has some concern about NO_2 levels. Currently, however, NO_2 is not monitored on our Reservation. Therefore, the Tribe recommends the Big Pine Indian Reservation be designated as "unclassifiable."

The Tribe looks forward to results of EPA's planned near-roadway monitoring network. Please keep us informed of any proposed changes for our region.
