NATIONAL APPROPRIATIONS PROCESS

 EPA develops a proposed budget in the winter for the upcoming fiscal year.

The President sends the federal budgets to Congress

 Congress considers the Presidents budget and enacts an appropriations bill – FY16 was enacted on December 15, 2015.


 The appropriation bill includes funding for EPA which becomes our blueprint for budget activities during the fiscal year



REGION 9'S BUDGET PROCESS

- Region 9 presents current and future (next fiscal) year funding information to tribes as available.
- Tribes present budget needs to EPA Senior Management to inform FUTURE budget requests.






CWA 104(b)3 – WETLANDS




