
The Quality Assurance Project Plan (QAPP)

QAPP PREPARATION IS A TERM & CONDITION IN YOUR GRANT

 EPA requires that all environmental data operations be performed under an approved QAPP

Environmental data operations refers to activities involving collection, generation, compilation, analysis, evaluation and use of environmental data.

- Field and laboratory (SOPs)








KEY TAKE AWAY SLIDE
