Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership (Enbridge) is requesting the elimination of two (2) boom locations from the E4 Containment system that is referenced as item Number 46 - E-4.0 Containment, subsection a, in accordance to the 2012 Morrow Lake Delta Containment Strategy Designs and Engineering Considerations Technical Memorandum as approved by United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) on June 26, 2012 in the March 14, 2013 U.S. EPA Order (Order).

Specifically, Enbridge is requesting a variance to the Order reducing the E-4.0 Containment structure from six (6) boom locations to four (4) boom locations by eliminating Location A and Location B. It is our opinion that eliminating the two (2) boom locations will allow the southern portion of the delta to remain open to the public.
