Per your letter of March 31, 2016 "Scope of Work Comments and Completion of Scoping under Section 3.1 of the Red Hill Fuel Storage Facility ("Red Hill") Administrative Order on Consent ("AOC"), Statement of Work ("SOW")," you provided comments to the AOC/SOW Section 3 Tank Upgrade Alternatives (TUA) outline submitted by the U.S. Department of the Navy ("Navy") and Defense Logistics Agency ("DLA") on January 29, 2016. In addition to the comments, you also
