    - Scored higher than Urban Denver sites
- Prioritized list of wetlands
  - Aid in protection/restoration efforts
  - o Detailed descriptions of CCD wetlands
  - o Overall picture of condition of CCD wetlands
  - o Baseline for future studies to determine improvements/declines
- Outcomes
  - o Increased understanding of location, extent, condition, type, and rarity of wetland resources
  - o Improved wetland protection efforts in project area from stakeholder involvement
- Management Recommendations
  - Water quality improvement
    - Reduce mowing to increase vegetation buffer sizes
    - Re-evaluate herbicide use in highly disturbed habitats
    - Increase forb diversity at restoration sites
  - Protect wetlands from development
