## Dear Interested Party:

Thank you for your letter regarding the Petition for Corrective Action or Dedelegation of Wisconsin's Authority to Administer the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permitting Program and the status of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Legal Authority Review (LAR) of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources' (WDNR) WPDES program.

As you are aware, the EPA sent a letter to WDNR on July 18, 2011 that identified 75 inconsistencies between the federal program requirements under the Clean Water Act and Wisconsin's statutory and regulatory authorities. The July 18th letter initiated a process to have WDNR strengthen the WPDES program by revising the appropriate Wisconsin rules and statutes to address the 75 identified issues spanning many topics. The process to resolve these issues is both technical and legal in nature and requires a detailed review. EPA is committed to working through each individual issue to completion.

Your letter expressed the concern that the WDNR believed that the identified 75 issues were resolved or close to resolution. Be assured that the EPA continues to focus on the LAR and does not consider it resolved. EPA has put together a tracking chart to track the State's progress in completing corrections for the 75 issues noted in EPA's letter. The chart is posted online at the following website: https://www.epa.gov/wi/npdes-petition-program-withdrawal-wisconsin-0. EPA intends to update the chart as the State completes its work. The EPA website also contains additional information related to the above-mentioned petition.
