Outdoor Cleanup Process

Cleanup has begun in outdoor residential areas. The representatives of the Unified Command will be reviewing individual properties on the north side of 52^{nd} Avenue in Maywood, CA to assess and cleanup the outdoor areas.

Outdoor Cleanup

All cleanup staff will have appropriate personal protective equipment, such as dust masks, gloves, boots, and coveralls to protect from contact with ash. While cleanup activities are taking place residents during the cleanup activities residents will not be allowed on the property. The ash will be collected using an industrial vacuum with HEPA filtration and the vacuum or a water rinse will be used to remove ash from items.

- **Roofs:** A 40' lift will be used to inspect the roof and visible ash will be collected, without walking on the roof, using the industrial vacuum.
- **Structures:** Visible ash will be removed from the outside walls of all structures using the industrial vacuum.
- **Concrete and/or asphalt surfaces:** Visible ash will be removed from all horizontal hard surfaces using the industrial vacuum.
- Lawns, plants, exposed soil: Visible ash will be removed using the industrial vacuum.
- **Outdoor Items:** Items such as plastic furniture, tools, toys, bicycles, etc. will be thoroughly rinsed with clean water within a temporary plastic enclosure to remove ash.

Next Steps

If there are no indoor concerns based on sampling results, the next step will be to schedule an appointment with the residents/owners to discuss the work that was completed outdoors. Residents/owners of homes on the north side of E. 52nd St. that were identified by indoor sampling as needing cleanup will be contacted to discuss that process.
