
Urban Waters Federal Grants Workshop San Antonio River Basin August 22^{nd,} 2016 Post-Workshop Evaluation


Overview

- On Monday, August 22nd, our local Urban Waters Federal Partnership hosted a one day, two session Federal Grants Workshop where EPA Region 6 and other experts discussed the ins and outs of the <u>Grants.gov</u> data base, as well as the components that make up a strong federal grant. Both sessions included roundtable discussions with select federal representatives, where attendees were given various opportunities to learn, collaborate and connect with them and other local Urban Waters partners.
- A week later, after attendees were given the opportunity to digest information and experience at the workshop, we asked them to provide us with their thoughts


Do You Feel Better Prepared to Begin the Federal Grants Application Process

Additional Questions

- When asked what piece of information they found the most helpful, 54% of respondents found the federal representation along with their expertise to be most useful, while 31% of respondents stated they found the Grants.gov tutorial beneficial.
- When asked if there was a specific topic that was not covered during the workshop, some respondents stated that they would like to see more field specific grant application processes (ex: Health Field) while others stated that they would have liked to know more about the grant peer review process

Additional Questions (cont.)

- A few respondents, 15%, found the opposite to be true of the Grants.gov and representative roundtable sessions, finding no benefit in them
- All respondents found the length of the workshop to be of adequate length (not too short, not too long)
