

# Western AUM Region Abandoned Uranium Mines

This map shows all known abandoned uranium mines in the Western AUM Region, with the exception of 4 mines off the map near the northern end of the Bodaway/Gap Chapter. Mines are located in the Cameron, Coalmine Canyon, Bodaway/Gap, and Leupp Chapters.

### On this map:

- Mines shown in purple will be assessed by El Paso Natural Gas, with EPA and Navajo EPA oversight.
- Mines shown in light blue will be assessed by Babbitt Ranches, with EPA and Navajo EPA oversight.
- Mines shown in dark blue will be assessed by the Navajo Environmental Response Trust, with Navajo EPA and EPA oversight.
- Mines shown in green: Coltec Industries has been sent notice by EPA that they are potentially responsible for addressing these areas.
- Mines shown in white will be addressed by EPA after priority mines are addressed.
- Regulated watering points are water hauling points that are regularly tested and monitored for uranium and other heavy metals, bacteria, and other contaminants.
- Unregulated water sources are not tested and monitored, and should only be used for livestock. These four unregulated water sources were also found to have elevated levels of uranium and other contaminants.
