





Chequamegon Bay Ecosystem

Climate Change Vulnerability



> Annual Stream and River Flow Trends and Precipitation Change 1950 - 2006




Climate Change Impact Assessment

- Magnitude
 - Changes in chlorophyll concentration/water clarity

- Mechanism
 - Temperature vs. altered hydrology


- Integrated Approach
 - Monitoring
 - Modeling

- Input Data Sets
- Condition and open land assessments




- Continuous discharge gage stations
 - 15-minute water levels
- Continuous data
 - Temp, SpCond, TSS
- Parameter loads (Grab/integrated samples)
 - TP, SRP, TN, NO3, TOC, DOC, TSS, SSC, E. Coli, DO






