This letter acknowledges receipt of the Primacy Revision Application dated September 30, 2015, submitted by Mr. Walter Ivey, Director of the Office of Environmental Health Services. This package modifies the West Virginia's Public Water System Supervision Program for the adoption of the Revised Total Coliform Rule (RTCR). West Virginia is commended for its efforts to timely adopt this rule before the April 1, 2016 compliance date.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has determined that West Virginia's Primacy Revision Application is complete and final. Interim primacy is granted pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §142.12(e) and remains in effect until EPA approves or disapproves the revised primacy program. EPA's ninety (90) day review period, as per 40 C.F.R. §142.12(d)(3), begins on the date of this letter. We will notify you of our decision.
