SUBJECT: Review of West Virginia's Primacy Revision Application and the Delegation of Authority for the Revised Total Coliform Rule for Region III

Thank you for submitting West Virginia's request to revise the state's primary enforcement authority (primacy) for the Revised Total Coliform Rule (RTCR). This memorandum constitutes concurrence from the Office of Ground Water and Drinking Water (OGWDW) on West Virginia's primacy revision request. The Office of General Counsel (OGC) has delegated review and approval of all packages to the Office of Regional Counsel (ORC).

West Virginia's primacy revision application package was complete and final in December 2015. My staff has reviewed the West Virginia primacy revision application and it is our opinion that West Virginia's requirements are as stringent as the federal requirements. Therefore, I concur with the approval of the primacy revision for West Virginia.
