Michigan's Challenges: Divided Legislature **Skeptical Public** User Groups Not Aligned Farmers, Manufacturers, Small Business, Aggregates, Fishing Folk, Food Processers, Cement Manufacturing....

Process:

Great Lakes Compact requires
Water Withdrawal Laws

Ideally adopt both Great Lakes Compact and Water Withdrawal Laws together

Water Legislation 2008: Agriculture's Role

- ✓ Compact in law Diversion's prohibited
 - ✓ Off to Congress.
 - Water content of products is not a diversion.
 - ✓ Provisions to protect role of Michigan Legislature.
- Riparian doctrine upheld.
- ✓ Water Use Assessment Tool
 - Evaluation period.
 - ✓ Science-based.
- Seasonal use provisions.
- ✓ No fees, no new rules.
- Existing uses grandfathered.
- ✓ Role for MDA, GAAMPs, Ag Commission.
- ✓ Additional reporting time.
- ✓ Water resources Advisory Council.
- Allowance for transferring grandfathered uses.






