Supermarket Industry 2010

- Median 46,000 sq ft per store

Standard Supermarket Construction Costs

- Industry 125 \$/Sq ft
- Typical \$5 to \$7 million per store
- Mechanical, Electrical, Controls, and HVAC about 20%



Maintenance Costs

- Most likely 1.50 -3.00 \$/ sq ft
- 65,000 to 130,000 \$ for an average 45,000 Sq Ft per Year



Supermarket Electrical Costs

- \$15,000 to \$30,000 average per month electric bills
- 300 to 500 KW demand
- 0.06 to 0.12 \$/KWH
- Approximately 50%-65% HVAC&R
- 15 to 20% lighting



Refrigerant Leak Rates and Charge

- Approximately 3500 to 4000 lb charges per store historically
- Average leak rate per year 25%
- Average refrigerant cost 7.50\$/lb
- Yearly expense of refrigerant \$7500
- Best Leak Rate in GreenChill
 - 9.9% for 2007 Giant Eagle and Harris Teeter
 - 7.8% for 2008 Giant Eagle
 - 6.9% for 2009 Giant Eagle and Sprouts
 - 6.5% for 2010 Spouts
