

# Environmental Enforcement Workshop Trans-boundary Import/Exports Compliance and Enforcement

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- Land
  - Hazardous Materials are allowed to come north thru 2 Ports of Entry:
    - Otay Mesa in San Diego County
    - Calexico in Imperial County
- Air
  - San Diego International Airport



#### Air entries



- San Diego International Airport
  - CBP has officers in the airport to inspect hazmat shipments.
  - If the officers are concerned with an entry, they will call the CBP HazMat specialists in Otay Mesa.
  - Air carriers tend to be very conservative about the HazMat that they allow on their airplanes.



- Northbound Inspections
  - Otay Mesa Port of Entry
    - Open Tuesday Friday
      - DTSC inspects Tuesday & Friday
      - San Diego County inspects Wednesday & Thursday
  - Calexico Port of Entry
    - Open Friday from 7 am 11 am
      - DTSC conducts the inspections





## Government agencies present at the Port of Entry













- DTSC/San Diego County purpose at the POE
  - To verify that all hazardous waste that is imported into California from Mexico is properly managed in accordance with the State of California laws and regulations



- What are we inspecting?
  - Hazardous Materials
    - Storage
    - Paperwork
    - Does it look like waste?
  - Hazardous Waste
    - Profile
    - Disposal Site
    - Manifest

### Northbound Inspections





- Type of Waste that come north
  - RCRA Waste
  - NonRCRA (California only) waste
  - Scrap Metal
  - Excluded Recyclable Materials
  - Universal Waste
  - Electronic Waste





- Laws and Regulations
  - Code of Federal Regulations Title 40
  - California Code of Regulations Title 22
  - California Health and Safety Code



- Otay Mesa
  - A total of 15-20 trucks arrive at the Port of Entry daily
  - Of those 5 10 carry waste
- Calexico
  - About 20 trucks arrive every Friday
  - Of those 4 5 carry waste



- Procedures for entry to the US at Otay Mesa
  - Business turns in Entry Paperwork to CBP 24 hours before shipment arrives at the POE.
  - CBP reviews paperwork and requests more information on a case by case basis
  - 7 am CBP allows entry to all trucks
  - Trucks drive thru the Radiation Portal Monitor
  - Trucks are aired out for at least 1 hour





- Procedures for entry to the US
  - DTSC/SD County review all paperwork for the trucks that have arrived
  - Physical Inspection of the shipments are conducted
    - Shipments are unloaded if we think it is necessary

### Northbound Inspections





- Enforcement
  - Enforcement action is taken if we observe violation in State regulations
    - Notice of Violation is issued and enforcement action is started
- There is currently 3 enforcement cases



- Trends
  - A lot less waste is coming to the US for disposal
  - Mexico has TSDF's that can accept a lot of the waste that is generated in the border cities.



- Not currently being conducted
  - O Draft inspection policy in the works between DTSC/SD County and CBP



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
