Bringing More Data to the Public this Quarter:

- Continued to increase EPA's information available on Data.gov (now over 1850 datasets/tools/geodata)
 - Added 4 new tools, focusing primarily on providing enforcement/legal information:
 - RadNet Map Interface for Near-Real-Time Radiation Monitoring Data
 - Unit Cost Compendium Calculations
 - Consolidated Recovered Materials Advisory Notice (RMAN) for the Comprehensive Procurement Guideline (CPG)
 - Selected Regional Judicial Officer Cases, 2005-Present
 - Added 6 new geodata sets
 - EPA Recovery Mapper
 - Water Quality Assessment Information
 - Nutrient, Sediment, and Pathogens Water Impairments
 - National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permitted Facilities
 - Pollutant Discharge Permit Status
 - Water Infrastructure Needs
