WINN-DIXIE & HUSSMANN PARTNER TO ACHIEVE LOUISIANA'S FIRST GREENCHILL CERTIFICATION

Bridgeton, Mo. – The new Winn-Dixie store in Covington, La., is the first supermarket in that state and only the 26th in the U.S. to achieve GreenChill silver certification, thanks to the use of Hussmann's energy-efficient refrigeration systems and display cases. Hussmann's Protocol distributed refrigeration system substantially reduces the store's overall refrigerant charge and leak rates, qualifying the new store for certification.

To qualify for this certification, Winn-Dixie had to demonstrate that it uses only refrigerants with zero ozone-depleting potential; allows a storewide annual refrigerant emissions rate of 15% or less; and achieves an average HFC refrigerant charge equal to or less than 1.75 pounds of refrigerant per 1,000 BTUs per hour of total evaporator cooling load.

With Hussmann's Protocol system, the store reduced its refrigerant charge by half compared to the industry average, leading to the GreenChill certification. Winn-Dixie was presented the award during its grand opening on February 2 by Keilly Witman, an EPA GreenChill spokesperson.

"People want to do business with stores that share their environmental values," said Witman. "By having the first GreenChill-certified store in Louisiana, Winn-Dixie has demonstrated to its customers and communities that it is serious about helping to save our Earth's ozone layer and fighting climate change."

Hussmann is a member of the GreenChill Advanced Refrigeration Partnership, a cooperative alliance with the supermarket industry to promote advanced technologies, strategies, and practices that reduce refrigerant charges and emissions of ozone-depleting substances and greenhouse gases.
