- 1. Investigate your School's Drinking Water Protection Area
 - 2. Plan for Action
- 3. Limit Activities at the Source (wellhead)
 - 4. Handle Chemicals and Fuel with Care
- 5. Train Staff on Chemical and Emergency Procedures
 - 6. Secure Water System Facilities and Hazardous Materials
- 7. Communicate with Staff, Students and Neighbors
 - 8. Save Water and Money
 - 9. Pay attention to Drinking Water when the School Expands
 - 10. Change Plans and Procedures over Time
