





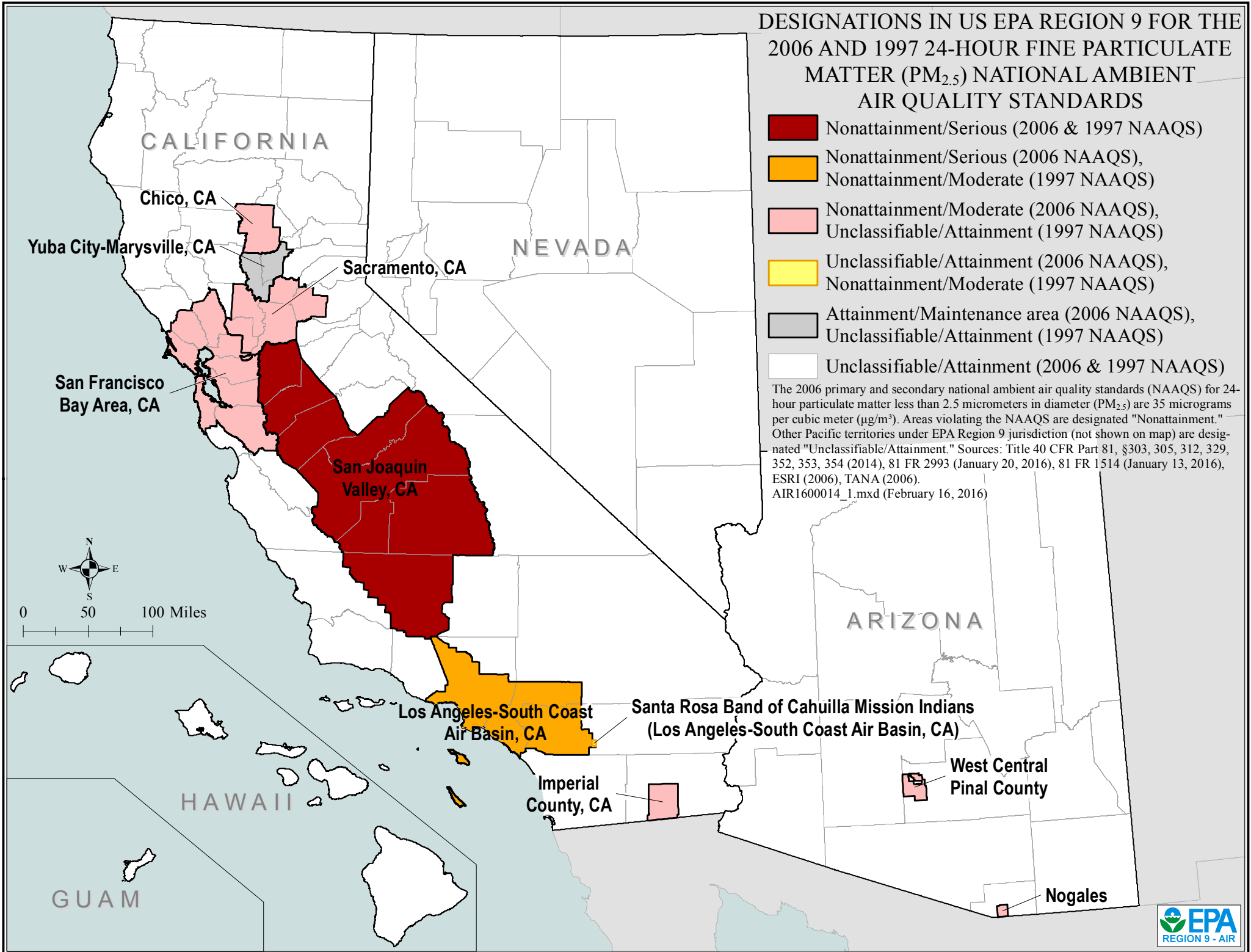

The 2006 primary and secondary national ambient air quality standards (NAAQS) for 24-hour particulate matter less than 2.5 micrometers in diameter (PM<sub>2.5</sub>) are 35 micrograms per cubic meter (µg/m<sup>3</sup>). Areas violating the NAAQS are designated "Nonattainment." Other Pacific territories under EPA Region 9 jurisdiction (not shown on map) are designated "Unclassifiable/Attainment."
