## What is the MC

• A shared target-based commitment of 5 gov'ts. to ensure effective conservation of their ecosystems.

➢ 30% near-shore marine resources

>20% terrestrial resources

#### Regional progress: Conservation

- Planning Meeting (Dec '06)
- Measures Meeting (Jun '08)
  - -Technical Workshop (Measures Group) – identify regional monitoring indicators
  - Communications Workshop (Comms Group) – dev. regional communications strategy
- Climate Change Workshop (Apr '09)



#### Regional progress: Fund-raising

- \$6m USD pledges from TNC & CI
- MC Endowment capitalized w/ \$1.5M (USD) from Palau
- GEF Proposal for \$6M (USD) for the endowment almost finalized
- LifeWeb Grant –\$1.5M Euro (\$1.9M USD) to assist on-going efforts



#### Challenges

- MC not yet well-understood by local communities
- Communications need improvement both at regional & local levels
- Effective conservation measures difficult to identify
- Sustainable financing mechanisms need high level commitment to be implemented
- Jurisdictions need to promote MC financial needs at international level



### Why MC Matters

- Fills in some existing gaps, but builds on on-going work
- Increases regional cooperation & coordination
- Increases access to critically needed resources (funding & technical assistance)
- Commitment to local people and cultures
- Puts Islands on the global stage (more visibility, more opportunity and access to assistance)
- Sets a benchmark for the world (Caribbean Challenge, Coral Triangle Initiative)



• An opportunity that can ensure a worthy inheritance of functional and intact ecosystems for Micronesians tomorrow.
