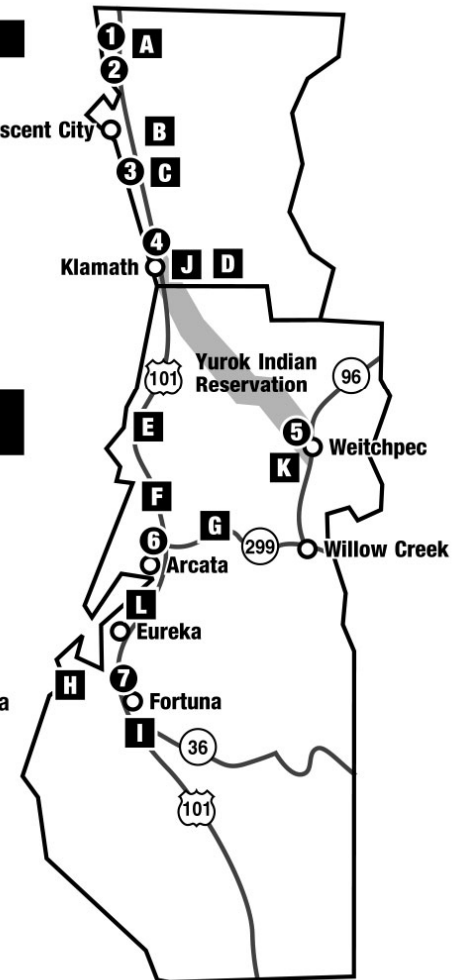

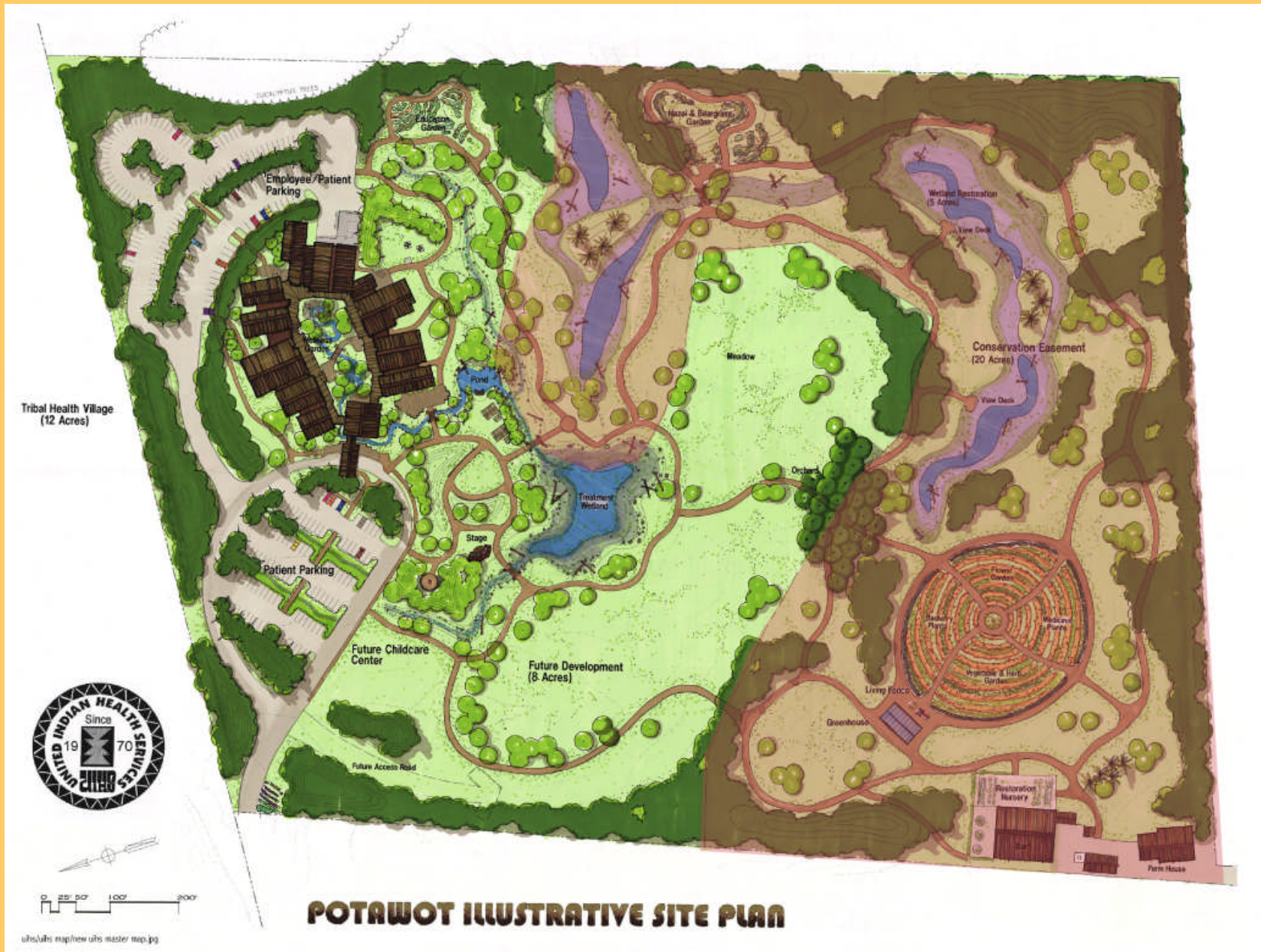

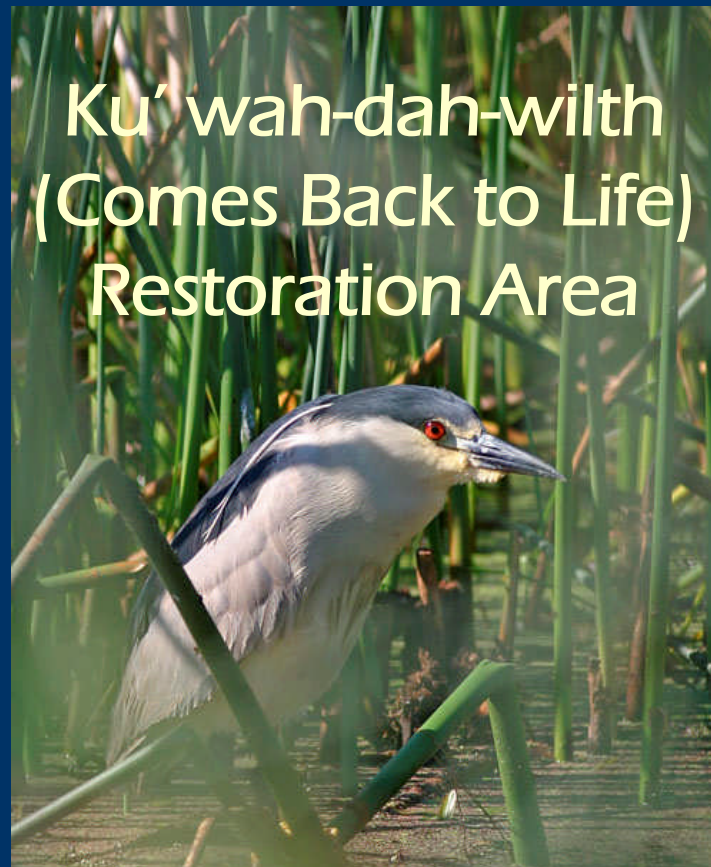
Village D: Tidil'-Tin
